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LISTENING TAPESCRIPT

Ben: So this means hearts and flowers are very important to my girlfriend?

Cindy: Yes, but think about what hearts and flowers mean. They represent love and romance. I think love and romance are important to your girlfriend.

Ben: OK, I have to remember that. It's fascinating stuff.
